REUNION "SAVE-THE-DATE" ANNOUNCEMENT

Dear NYC Chinatown Reunion Friends,

Plans have been made for another reunion in Las Vegas, so save the following dates: Monday, May 14, 2012 to Friday, May 18, 2012. More information with prices and registration form to follow.

If you know of any old friends who grew up in New York City or Chinatown and would like to attend our reunion, please give me their email address or forward the information to them.

If space is available, the non-Reunion people may register at a later date, however, they will not be allowed into the Reunion Buffet unless there is space available. Seating is limited and reserved for the Reunion people. Although we will have many who want to join our Reunion Dinner, those Reunion people with reserved rooms will have first preference. 400 people can be seated for the banquet rooms, but we can probably accommodate about 20 more.

I've been asked about combining a cruise with the reunion and because the weather in May will be more conducive for traveling, I'm putting together a group for a **pre-reunion** cruise to the Mexican Riviera leaving May 6, 2012 and returning May 13, 2012 from Long Beach, CA. So, if you have any desire to cruise, great for first time cruisers, this would be the time to "get your feet wet." I am holding (5) inside cabins and (5) balcony cabins. A fully **refundable** deposit of \$25 will hold a spot for you until May 11, 2011 and then an additional **refundable** deposit of \$225 is due. Final payment would be due February 21, 2012. No refunds after final payment. Additional information will be forwarded upon request.

Travel insurance is highly recommended for senior travelers as it will cover cancellations due to family illnesses or worse. I will forward this information also, if requested.
